Ropes and Living History Assistants Sign-Up Sheet:

Please use this sheet to make sure you have enough chaperones to fill all (ropes & living history) positions.

Ropes:

Chaperone assistance is needed to assure the safety of our ropes course classes. Training will be provided for all assistants prior to each rope course. We need five volunteers to run the rope course Polaris. (S) is the stair case monitor. This position is located ³/₄ the way up the stairs and keeps the students organized into two lines. (N) is the cargo Net spotter, who will stand at the base of the cargo net and actively spot one climber at a time up the net. (D) is the dismount position, who will wait near the end of the zip line to assist the students off. (C) is the coach, who will walk around underneath the course to spread JOY and encouraging thoughts. The coach should also monitor and supervise all students on the ground. Unfortunately, we cannot promise additional adults the opportunity to go up on the course.
